Our Bequest Program is named after Dr Georgina Sweet, a determined and accomplished woman, who invested considerable time, energy and resources into the establishment of University Women's College.



Who was Dr Georgina Sweet?

Dr Georgina Sweet DSC OBE was a driving force behind the establishment of University Women's College and was Chairman of the Provisional Committee that campaigned to secure the land on which the College now stands.



She was a brilliant academic, and the first woman to be awarded a Doctor of Science at the University of Melbourne and the first woman to serve on the university's Council.

As well as dedicating her time to the College, Georgina Sweet also endowed one of our first scholarships. Following her death in 1946, she left a substantial bequest to the College, the proceeds of which still support students to this day.

In recognition of Dr Sweet's long and distinguished service to the College, our bequest society was named in her honour.
